**Stepping:** Duns Tew double-step, hockle-back, foot-together-jump **Source:** Rebecca Jordan / Lemon & Capers **Chorus:** #1 & #3: "birdcage" & half hey. Repeat. #2 & #4: "cannons" & half hey. Repeat.  
**Sequence:** once to yourself, foot up, chorus/birdcage, face-to-face, chorus/cannons, top-to-bottom, chorus/birdcage, bottom-to-top, chorus/cannons, rounds & all-in
