Style: Sherborne (Cotswold) **Tune:** *Constant Billy* **Type:** set/2 19" (short) sticks **Dancers:** 6 (can be modified for 4) **Stepping:** Sherborne stepping: double-step, foot-together-jump, shuffle-backs, foot-together-jump **Source:** Tim Radford **Chorus:** sticking together-right-together-left-together-right-together-both, half hey. Repeat. **Sequence:** once to yourself, foot up (moving), chorus, set, chorus, back-to-back, chorus, face-to-face, chorus, small rounds, whole hey, large rounds
